




Safe Steps is a secure, digital falls prevention app easy to setup and configure for different types of care organisation



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Safe Steps - Case study #1


Wirral Health & Care Commissioning

- First live site in the UK
- 66 care homes using Safe Steps since Dec 2018
 - 179 staff members
 - 937 residents
 - 5,738 screenings conducted
- CCG outcomes data validated:
 - 14,000+ risks identified across the system leading to earlier identification & intervention
 - 28% less falls (vs previous 12 months)
 - Approximate cost saving of £180k through reduced non-elected admissions
- Currently scaling up into all 78 care homes





Safe Steps - Case study #2









Bolton CCG

- 10 care homes engaged as part of a 12 month pilot
- Implemented as part of overall care home improvement programme
- Trained and onboarded pilot homes and measured outcomes against a 'control group'.
- CCG outcomes data validated:
 - 19% less falls (vs Control group)
 - 33% less falls (vs All homes)
 - 41% less NWAS callouts (vs Control grou
 - 21% less NWAS callouts (vs All homes)
- Currently scaling up into all 50+ care homes prioritising homes with highest rate of falls

Safe Steps - Case study #3

Stamford Unit

- Implemented into a 93 bed intermediate care unit on grounds of Tameside General hospital
- Trained and onboarded 46 nurses and staff with localised configuration and interventions
- T&G Trust outcomes data validated:
 - 3,000+ assessments
 - o 16,000+ risks identified for 664 patients
 - o 29% fewer falls (vs Jul-Dec 2018)
- Currently identifying further features for development within the 'hospital' setting
- Looking for other similar intermediate care settings for further pilots and evaluation


