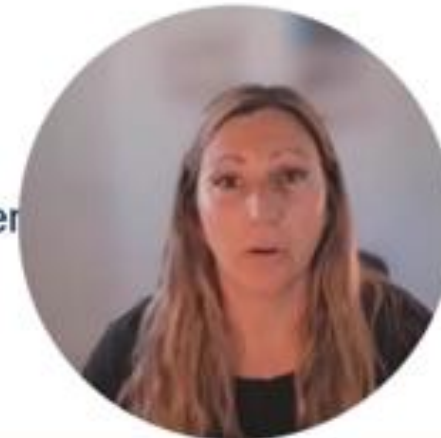

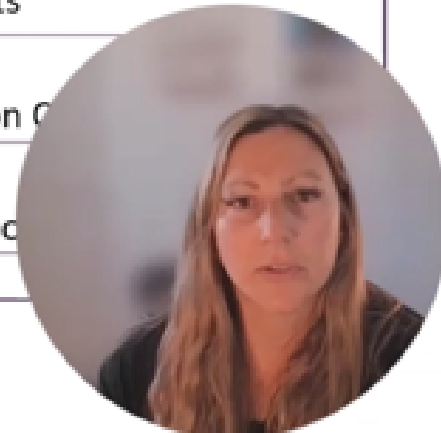

Supporting people earlier

Early tracked outcomes are strong:

- ~**95%** of individuals in the trusted assessor pathway remain outside formal services **3 months later**
- Only **8–9%** of those enter social care within **six months**
- **9.2** months is the average stay in prevention before entering statutory services
- **£47.73** average cost per person per month
- Average **1,239** residents per month in our prevention pathway
